The tax hereby levied shall not apply to the following sales:

(II) SAIES MADE IN HOSPITAL THRIFT SHOPS OPERATING WITH ALL VCIUNTEEF PERSONNEL AND THAT SELL DONATED ARTICLES AND CONTRIBUTE THE PROFITS TO THE HOSPITAL IN WHICH THEY ARE LOCATED SELLING ONLY ICNATED ARTICLES AND CONTRIBUTING THE PROFITS THEREFROM IC THE HOSPITAL WITH WHICH THEY ARE ASSOCIATED AND WHICH ARE NOT OPERATED IN CONJUNCTION WITH GIFT SHOPS OR OTHER RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS.

SECTION 2. AND FE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
