compensation of the inspectors, the [compensation] SALARY of the administrator as limited herein, compensation of other personnel, who shall be qualified and employed under the county merit system, printing, supplies, and office space, shall be at the discretion of the County Council for Prince George's County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June July 1, 1978.

Frince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages (Attorney to the Foard of License Commissioners)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2E - Alcoholic Beverages

155.

(q) In Prince George's County each of the members of the hoard, except the chairman [thereof], shall receive an annual salary of \$6,000 and the chairman shall receive an annual salary of \$6,500. The board shall meet at least two times per month. The administrator of the board [who] shall be appointed by and serve at the will of the board and [who] shall devote full time and attention to the duties of the board shall receive an annual salary of not less than [ten thousand dcllars (\$10,000.00);] \$10,000 nor more than [fifteen thousand dcllars (\$15,000)] \$15,000 to be set by
