

~~(E) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, TO THE EXTENT THAT FEDERAL AND STATE LAW AND REGULATIONS PERMIT, SHALL PAY, OR PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT FROM STATE FUNDS, ALL MEDICAL, DENTAL, SURGICAL, AND PHARMACEUTICAL EXPENSES OF ALL CHILDREN RECEIVING BOARDING CARE (FOSTER CARE).~~

(E) IN RESPECT TO MEDICAL COSTS INCURRED BY A CHILD IN FOSTER CARE IN THE DEPARTMENT'S FOSTER CARE PROGRAM, THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES SHALL REIMBURSE FOSTER CARE PROVIDERS FOR ANY CO-PAYMENT FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS, FOR THE COST OF PHYSICIAN RECOMMENDED NONPRESCRIPTION DRUGS, FOR REPLACEMENT OF EYEGLASSES, AND FOR ANY OTHER SERVICE RECEIVED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1978 WHICH WAS COVERED BY THE REGULATION OF THE STATE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ON DECEMBER 31, 1975, PROVIDED THAT THESE EXPENDITURES ARE NOT REIMBURSABLE UNDER THE STATE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 901

(House Bill 815)

AN ACT concerning

Community Colleges - Annual Operating Budget

FOR the purpose of requiring annual operating budgets of community colleges to show all revenues and expenditures; providing for certain categories of revenues and expenditures; and generally relating to the contents of the operating budgets of community colleges.
