SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

90.

- (A) AS OF JULY 1, 1978, PERSONS EMPLOYED BY SOMERSET COUNTY, WHO OPERATE STATE-OWNED EQUIPMENT USED IN THE PERMANENT STATE MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM, SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR—AFFICINTMENT—TO—A-COMPARABLE—FOSITION—IN—THE—CLASSIFIED SERVICE—UNDER—THIS—ARTICLE—WITHOUT—EXAMINATION—OR—FURTHER QUALIFYING—BEQUIREMENT—
- 1E) THE EMILOYEES MAY NOT SUFFER A DIMINUTION OF SALABY OF WAGES, ACCRUED LEAVE, WHETHER EARNED OR GRANTED, OF SENICEITY RIGHTS. ANY INCREASE IN SALABY OR WAGES GRANTED SUBSECUENT TO PASSACE OF THE LEGISLATION ENABLING THE TEANSFER, MAY BE RETAINED ON APPOINTMENT TO THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE CNIY IF THE SECFETARY OF PERSONNEL APPROVES. THE SECRETABY OF PERSONNEL APPROVES. THE SECRETABY OF PERSONNEL APPROVES. THE ANY AND ALL OTHER BENEFITS, ENTITLEMENTS, SERVICES OF PERSONAL AND, AT HIS DISCRETION AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE, MAY CONSIDER THESE VALUES OR A PORTION OF THEM WHEN ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF SALABY ON APPOINTMENT. AFTER APPOINTMENT, THE EMPLOYEES ARE ENTITLED TO THE SAME BENEFITS PROVIDED TO CLASSIFIED EMILOYEES FSTABLISHED BY THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
