(Eouse Eill 935)

AN ACT concerning

Occupational Therapy Practice

911. DEFINITIONS.

- (A) IN THIS SUFTITLE THE FCILCWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (E) "ASSOCIATION" MEANS THE MARYLAND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION.
- (C) "BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF CCCUPATIONAL THERAPY PRACTICE.
- (D) "LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO PRACTICE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY.
