8-410. ESTIMATES OF NUMBER OF CHILDREN RECEIVING SERVICES AND ANNUAL COST.

EACH PLAN FOR SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES SUBMITTED BY A COUNTY BOARD AND EACH PLAN DEVELOPED AND ADOPTED BY THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL INCLUDE:

(1) A DETAILED ESTIMATE OF THE NUMBER OF CHILDREN WHO WILL RECEIVE SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES UNDER THE PLAN; AND

(2) THE ANNUAL COST OF IMPLEMENTING THE PLAN.

8-411. COOPERATION OF COUNTY BOARDS WITH HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.

(A) COUNTY BOARD TO FURNISH INFORMATION TO COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL GIVE THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ANY INFORMATION THE BOARD RECEIVES AS TO HANDICAPPED CHILDREN WHO LIVE IN ITS COUNTY.

(B) COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS AND REFERRALS.

THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) RECOMMEND WHICH OF THESE HANDICAPPED CHILDREN NEED ADDITIONAL DIAGNOSTIC OR TREATMENT SERVICES; AND

(2) REFER THESE CHILDREN TO THE COUNTY BOARD FOR EVALUATION.

(C) COUNTY BOARD RESPONSIBLE FOR IDENTIFICATION OF HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.
