CHANGE IN THE TYPE OR SCOPE OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES, INCLUDING HEALTH CARE SERVICES OFFERED IN SPACE LEASED FROM THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY, IN EXCESS OF LIMITS UPON SUCH CHANGE OR RELOCATION FSTABLISHED BY THE STATE AGENCY, EXCEPT THAT THIS FFCVISION SHALL NOT APPLY TO AN INCREASE OR DECREASE IN MAGNITUCE OF ANY SINGLE PATIENT SERVICE OVER A 2-YEAR FERIOD, BY WHICH THE FACILITY PLANS TO CHANGE THE VOLUME OF THE SERVICE FY LESS THAN 25 PERCENT;

(II) A CHANGE IN FED CAPACITY, IN EXCESS OF THE LIMITS ESTABLISHED IN THE FEDERAL ACT EXCEPT THAT THIS FECULION SHALL NCT AFPLY TO A CHANGE IN BED CAPACITY WHICH DOES NOT INCREASE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BEDS BY MORE THAN 10 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL BED CAPACITY, WHICHEVER IS IESS, OVER A 2-YEAR PERIOD:

(III) A CAPITAL EXPENDITURE IN EXCESS OF THE LIMITS-ESTABLISHED IN THE FEDERAL ACT. EXCEPT THAT THIS PROVISION SHALL NOT AFFLY TO:

- (K) "FEALTH CAFE SERVICE" MEANS A CLINICALLY RELATED PATIENT SERVICE PROVIDED BY A PERSON OR PROVIDED IN OR TEFOUGE A HEALTH CARE FACILITY.

- (M) "STATE AGENCY" MEANS THE MARYLAND HEALTH PLANNING AND DEVELORMENT AGENCY.
- (N) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.
- (O) "HEALTH SYSTEM PLAN" MEANS ANY PLAN OR MCDIFICATION OR ADDITION THERETO ACOPTED BY A HEALTH SYSTEM AGENCY PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL ACT TO ESTABLISH AND PRESCRIPT THE HEALTH CARE GOALS AND OFFICTIVES FOR ITS ASSIGNED AREA.
