

by public authority, which pledges, LOANS, and gifts are acquired or donated for this project, shall be considered as part of the ~~equal and matching~~ funds required to be provided by the Lyric Foundation, Inc., [or University of Baltimore Educational Foundation, Inc., or both,] or [their] ITS successor [or successors] in interest, and Baltimore City, under the terms of this section.

(2) The Board of Public works shall determine and establish the value of any property, other than cash, and shall also determine whether or not any pledge of cash is bona fide and binding OR ANY LOAN IS GUARANTEED so as to meet the requirements necessary to be considered as part of the ~~equal and matching~~ funds.

(c) For the purpose of this section, any successor [or successors] in interest must be a tax exempt organization.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 913

(House Bill 1008)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Governor

FOR the purpose of stating the amount of pension available to a governor who has retired under certain circumstances; providing for certain adjustments in that amount; providing for effective dates of change; and generally relating to the pension provided for retired governors and their spouses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
