- (1) ELK NECK (CECIL COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 2,268 ACRES.....\$300,000
- (2) GREEN RIDGE (ALLEGANY COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 51,477 ACRES.....\$400,000
- (3) INDIAN SPRINGS (WASHINGTON COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 6,811 ACRES.....\$200,000
- (4) ISLANDS OF THE POTOMAC: THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 2,352 ACRES .....\$100,000
- (5) JAMES ISLAND (SOMERSET COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 3,150 ACRES.....\$250,000
- (6) ~~PATUXENT RIVER PARK~~ LARGO PATUXENT RIVER PARK (PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY) FOR LAND NORTH OF CENTRAL AVENUE (ROUTE 214) AND EAST OF CHURCH ROAD: THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 1,200 ACRES.....\$1,000,000
- (7) MERKLE (PRINCE GEORGE'S & CALVERT COUNTIES): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 2,420 ACRES.....\$500,000
- (8) MONOCACY (MONTGOMERY & FREDERICK COUNTIES): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 2,400 ACRES.....\$250,000
- (9) MORGAN FUN (CARROLL COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 1,500 ACRES.....\$200,000
- (10) PATAPSCO VALLEY (HOWARD, CARROLL, BALTIMORE, & ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTIES): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 11,171 ACRES....\$1,500,000
- (11) POINT LOCKOUT (ST. MARY'S COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 705 ACRES .... \$200,000
- (12) ST. MARY'S RIVER (ST. MARY'S COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 2,481 ACRES.....\$300,000
- (13) SENECA CREEK (MONTGOMERY COUNTY): THE LAND ACQUISITION PROGRAM MAY NOT EXCEED 6,609 ACRES.....\$500,000
