

Section 1. (2) (J) (5) (e) - State Colleges, Towson State College (Baltimore County): Funds for parking at Towson State College. The amount represents the cost of surface parking for 600 cars; Towson State College, with the approval of the Board of Trustees of State Colleges, may use the funds for part of the cost of constructing a parking structure to be located in the built-up area of the campus; the remaining part of the cost of the parking structure shall be provided by the college from other than State general obligation bonds or State general funds; the project is contingent upon approval of the Board of Trustees of the State Colleges and the Board of Public Works (Baltimore County).....350,000

Section 1. (2) (M) (1) (e) - Department of Economic and Community Development, Maryland Historical Trust: Funds to city of Havre de Grace for planning, archaeological restoration and reconstruction of the Susquehanna and Tidewater Lock House Building, canal and locks for public benefit, providing that the city guarantees the cost of operating and maintaining the property contingent upon assurances that no further State funds will be sought for this restoration (Harford County).....95,000
