

AN ACT concerning

Talbot ~~County~~ and Calvert Counties - Use of Public Schools  
or Election Days

FOR the purpose of allowing public schools in Talbot ~~County~~  
and Calvert Counties to remain open on election days.

BY adding to

Article - Education  
Section 7-103(c) (4)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(As enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ of the Acts  
of the General Assembly of 1978)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland  
{as enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ of the Acts of the General  
Assembly of 1978) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read  
as follows:

Article - Education

7-103.

(c) (4) IN TALBOT ~~COUNTY~~ AND CALVERT COUNTIES,  
NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, THE  
PUBLIC SCHOOLS MAY REMAIN OPEN AND IN SESSION ON PRIMARY AND  
GENERAL ELECTION DAYS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act  
shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 926

(House Bill 1279)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - St. Mary's County Jail

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt  
in the amount of \$200,000, the proceeds to be used to  
assist in the construction, renovation, rehabilitation,  
and equipping of the existing St. Mary's County Jail  
facility, subject to the provision that the Board of  
County Commissioners of St. Mary's County provide at  
least an equal and matching fund for the same purpose;  
and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds
