8-417.1. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN §§ 8-417.1 THROUGH 8-417.6 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

- (B) BASIC COST.
- (1) "EASIC COST", AS TO EACH COUNTY, MEANS THE AVERAGE AMOUNT SPENT BY THE COUNTY FROM COUNTY, STATE, AND FEDERAL SOURCES FOR THE PUBLIC EDUCATION OF A NONHANDICAPPED CHILD.
- (2) "BASIC COST" DOES NOT INCLUDE AMOUNTS SPECIFICALLY ALLOCATED AND SPENT FOR IDENTIFIABLE COMPENSATORY PROGRAMS FOR DISADVANTAGED CHILDREN.
  - (C) COUNTY BOARD.

"COUNTY BOARD", IF APPROPRIATE, INCLUDES THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY.

- (D) EXCESS COST.
- (1) "EXCESS COST" MEANS THE COST OF PROVIDING SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES UNDER §§ 8-401 THROUGH 8-409 OF THIS SUBTITLE IN EXCESS OF THE BASIC COST.
  - (2) "EXCESS COST" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
- (I) FEDERAL FUNDS RECEIVED OR RECEIVABLE BY THE STATE OR THE COUNTIES UNDER ANY FEDERAL PROGRAM THAT IS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED TO ASSIST IN THE FINANCING OF SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS OR SERVICES: AND
- (II) THE COST OF PLACING CHILDREN IN NONPUBLIC EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AS PROVIDED IN §8-409 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
  - (E) STUDENTS ENROLLED.
- (1) "STUDENTS ENROLLED" MEANS ALL STUDENTS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN GRADES KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 12 OR THEIR EQUIVALENT IN REGULAR DAY SCHOOL PROGRAMS.
- (2) "STUDENTS ENROLLED" IN BALTIMORE COUNTY INCLUDES THE STUDENTS IN THE LIDA LEE TALL SCHOOL OF TOWSON STATE UNIVERSITY.
  - (F) WEALTH.
