(III) EE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE SERVING REQUIRED TO SERVE IN A SIMILAR SCHOOL DAY TEACHING CAPACITY IN ANCTEER SUBJECT AREA FOR WHICH HE OR SHE IS CERTIFIED.

SECTION 2. AND EF IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

## CHAPTER 934

(Hcuse Bill 1449)

AN ACT corcerning

Cr€ation of a State Debt - Memorial Stadium

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$1,000,000, the proceeds to be used for a State grant to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the construction, renovation, improvement, and equipping of Memorial Stadium on 33rd Street in the City of Baltimore, including the payment of architects' and engineers' fees; specifying certain conditions—for—the—payment—of—these—funds; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing such—leans the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. That:

- (1) The Board of Public Works may berrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Memorial Stadium Lean of 1978 in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,000,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1977 Supplement, as amended from time to time).
- (2) The bonds issued to evidence this loan or installments thereof may be sold as a single issue, or may be consclidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under § 2E of Article 31 of the Code.
- (3) The actual cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and shall be first applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing and delivering the bonds unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided
