CHAPTER 946

(Senate Bill 1097)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Industrial Development Authority Bonds

FOR the purpose of ~~including in the definition of industrial building or buildings for the purpose of permitting municipalities and counties to issue revenue bonds for the financing of these industrial buildings certain personal and real property and improvements used for practice facilities by professional or amateur athletic or sports teams or organizations in Anne Arundel County~~ altering the definition of "industrial building" or "buildings" so as to permit municipalities and counties to issue revenue bonds for the financing of these industrial buildings where certain personal and real property improvements are made to practice facilities used for or by professional and amateur athletic or sports teams or organizations in Anne Arundel County, or where improvements are made to planned recreational parks and ancillary facilities in Anne Arundel County; providing that these athletic or sports teams or organizations are industrial concerns for certain purposes; and making this Act an emergency measure.
