- (a) A-minor-shall-have the same capacity to consent to medical treatment as an adult if one or more of the following apply:
- (1) The-minor-is-married-or—the--parent--of--a
- (2) The minor seeks treatment or advice concerning veneral disease, pregnancy or contraception not amounting to sterilization, OR IS THE VICTIM OF AN ALLEGED RAPE OR SEXUAL OFFENSE.
- (3) In the judgment of a physician treating a minor, the obtaining of consent or the notification of any other person would result in such delay of treatment as would adversely affect the life or health of the minor.
- (4) The sinor seeks -- treatment -- or -- advice concerning -- any -- form -- of -drug -- abuse -as defined in Section 2 (d) of Article 43B of the Annotated Code -
- (5) The-minor-seeks--treatment-or-advice concerning-any-form-of-alcoholism-as-defined-in-§-103(c)-of Article-2C-of-the-Annotated-Gode-

## 135B.

A MINOR WHO IS THE VICTIM OF AN ALLEGED RAPE OR SEXUAL OFFENSE HAS THE SAME CAPACITY AS AN ADULT TO CONSENT TO A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING AND GATHERING INFORMATION AND EVIDENCE AS TO THE CRIME.
