TITLE 12. STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

SUBTITLE 1. IN GENERAL.

12-101. BOARD ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION.

12-102. COMPOSITION: TERM: VACANCIES: COMPENSATION.

(A) COMPOSITION.

THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION CONSISTS OF 11 MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

- (B) TERM AND VACANCIES.
- (1) EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD SERVES FOR A TERM OF 5 YEARS AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THESE TERMS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON THE FOARD AS OF JULY 1, 1978.
- (2) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (3) A MEMBER MAY BE REAPPOINTED BUT MAY NOT SERVE MORE THAN TWO FULL 5-YEAR TERMS.
 - (C) COMPENSATION.

EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

- (1) SERVES WITHOUT COMPENSATION; AND
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.
 - (D) RESTRICTION ON OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES.

DURING HIS MEMBERSHIP ON THE BOARD, A MEMBER MAY NOT BE EMPLOYED BY OR BE A MEMBER OF THE GOVERNING OR ADVISORY BOARD OF ANY AGENCY OR ANY INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION THAT IS SUBJECT TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE BOARD.
