

CHAPTER 986

(Senate Bill 826)

AN ACT concerning

Private Detectives - Licenses to Conduct Business

FOR the purpose of requiring a private detective licensee to maintain a ~~principal an~~ office in this State; requiring certain records to be kept in this State; and requiring the principal office to be under the control of a the offices of a licensee to be under the supervision of an individual licensee who is a resident of this State.
