

(1) COORDINATE THE OVERALL GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION IN THIS STATE; AND

(2) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, CONSULT WITH EACH AGENCY AND INSTITUTION THAT IS AFFECTED DIRECTLY BY ITS ACTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS BEFORE TAKING FINAL ACTION ON THEM.

(C) STATE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION COMMISSION.

THE BOARD IS THE STATE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION COMMISSION UNDER TITLE XII OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT OF 1965.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 77A, §32(a).

The present reference to the Higher Education Act "as amended from time to time" is deleted as unnecessary in light of Art. 1, §21 of the Code.

The only other changes are in style.

(D) ADMINISTRATION OF STATE FUNDS.

THE BOARD SHALL:

(1) ADMINISTER STATE FUNDS FOR PRIVATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS; AND

(2) ASSURE THAT THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH THE FUNDS WERE APPROPRIATED ARE MET.

(E) PLANS AND PROGRAMS FOR INTERSTATE AND REGIONAL COOPERATION.

THE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP, IMPLEMENT, AND ADMINISTER PLANS AND PROGRAMS FOR INTERSTATE AND REGIONAL COOPERATION, INCLUDING RECIPROCALITY AGREEMENTS ON MATTERS THAT AFFECT HIGHER EDUCATION.

It should be noted that Art. 77A, §32D provides that after July 1, 1977 the State Board for Higher Education shall administer all education
