basis insofar as price is concerned.

SECTION 1. BE IT FNACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 11-301(b) through 11-301(f), respectively, of Article - Commercial Law, of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 11-301(c) through 11-301(g), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

## Article - Commercial Law

11-301.

- "CONTROLLED CUTLET" MEANS AN CUTLET WHICH IS (B) OPERATIC BY A DISTRIBUTOR OR OPERATED BY COMPANY EMPLOYEES. A SUBSICIABY COMPANY, CCMMISSIONED AGENT, OR BY ANY PERSON WHO MANAGES THE OUTLET ON A FEE ARRANGEMENT WITH THE DISTRIBUTOE.
- "FARM COOPERATIVE" MEANS A CCOPERATIVE ORGANIZED UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF TITLE 5 OF THE CORPORATIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS ARTICLE.
- "INDEPENDENT JOBBER" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO (F) PURCHASES GASOLINE PRODUCTS FROM A WHOLESALER FOR RESALE TO A DEALER.

11-304.

- (1) A DISTRIBUTOR WHO SETS THE RETAIL PRICE OF GASOLINE THROUGH CONTROLLED OUTLETS SHALL PROVIDE THOSE NONCONTROLLED OUTLETS THAT IT SUPPLIES WITH GASOLINE PRODUCTS AT A WHOLESALE PRICE OF AT LEAST 4 CENTS PER GALLON UNDER THE LOWEST PRICE POSTED FOR EACH GRADE OF GASOLINE AT ANY CCNTECLIED OUTLET. VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION CCNSTITUTES PRICE DISCRIMINATION AS PROHIBITED BY 8-11-204(3) 11-204(A) (3) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- THE FRCVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL NOT APPLY TO INDEFENDENT JOBBEES AND FARM COOPERATIVES.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
