(House Bill 608)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicle - Scrap Processors and Abandoned Vehicles

FOR the purpose of ~~abolishing the State subsidy (bounty) for the scrap processor program~~ requiring that certain payments made to scrap processors shall be suspended under certain circumstances and that the payments shall be resumed under certain circumstances; and generally relating to abandoned vehicles, bounties on such vehicles, and presumptions of ownership.
