AN ACT concerning

Air Quality Control Standards

FOR the purpose of previding utility kill savings to Maryland citizens while maintaining air quality at levels-fully-adequate-to-protect—the health, general welfare, and property of the people of the State; requiring certain regulations of the Department of Health and Mental Eygiene governing ambient air quality to be identical to national air quality standards; requiring that certain emission standards be established for certain stationary sources; and providing a transition period for the promulgation of regulations; and requiring that all-fuel cost savings consequently realized by public service companies be fully applied—to-reduce—electric—bills-rendered to gustomers.
