SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article £1 - Revenue and Taxes

29.

- (A-1) FAILURE TO SEND A NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT WITHIN THE TIMES-HEREAFTER-SPECIFIED 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF FINALITY IN THE CLASSES OF CASES SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPHS (A) (1), (A) (2), (A) (3), AND (A) (4) OF THIS SECTION CREATES AN IRREFUTTABLE FRESUMFTICN THAT THE ASSESSMENT HAS NOT CHANGED FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S ASSESSMENT, UNLESS, ONE OF THE FCLLOWING CONDITIONS HAS OCCURRED:
- (1) THE PROPERTY HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED FOR CONSIDERATION TO NEW CWNERSHIP DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR:
- (2) THERE EAS BEEN A CHANGE IN THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF THE PROPERTY DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR, RESULTING IN AN INCREASED VALUE OF THE PROPERTY;
- (3) A SUESTANTIAL CHANGE HAS OCCURRED IN THE USE OF THE PROPERTY DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR;
- (4) EXTENSIVE IMPROVEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE ON THE EXISTING PROPERTY CURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR;
- (5) THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE PREVIOUS TAXABLE YEAR WAS CIEARLY ERRCNEOUS DUE TO AN ERROR IN CALCULATION OR MEASUREMENT OF IMPROVEMENTS ON THE PROPERTY; AND
  - (6) THE ASSESSMENT HAS BEEN DECREASED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect June-1,-1978 January 1, 1979.
