While every Marylander benefits from Somerset County land these lands owned by the State, the fiscal consequence places a burden on the residents of the each County. The reduced tax base makes it difficult for the county government governments to provide funds for necessary services such as schools and roads.

The federal government has recognized the fact that land taken out of the tax base reduces the revenues of local jurisdictions. It uses revenue sharing funds to compensate local jurisdictions for taxes lost on federally—owned land. RESOLVED, That the commission be composed of seven members which include the Comptroller of Maryland or his designate, the State Senator elected from the 36th Legislative District, one member of the House of Delegates from the 36th Legislative District, a person nominated by the County Commissioners of Somerset County, the Treasurer of Somerset County, three members of the Maryland House of Delegates, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, two members of the Maryland Senate, to be appointed by the President of the Maryland Senate, and the Executive Director of the Maryland Association of Counties, and a resident of Somerset County; and be it further

RESOLVED, That secretarial and staff assistance shall be provided by the Department of Fiscal Services; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the commission report its recommendations to the Maryland General Assembly no later than January 10, 1979; and be it further
