FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to create a debt, and to issue and sell its certificates of indebtedness as evidence thereof, to an amount not exceeding ~~One Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars - (\$1,250,000)~~ One Million Five Hundred
