In accordance with Article II, Section 17, of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 810.

This bill revises the manner in which the State actuary shall compute the contribution to the Employees' Retirement System of members who are employees of participating municipal corporations.

House Bill 1306, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 16, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 810.
