In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 1166.

This bill requires that the Maryland Register contain a certification that it contains all regulations and documents codified as of a specific date.

House Bill 1716, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 16, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1166.
