In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 405.

This bill exempts from the retail sales tax the sale of fcod in certain instances.

House Bill 404, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 29, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose in a more comprehensive fashion.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 405.
