In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 909.

This bill corrects an erroneous statutory reference to the governing body of the Blind Industries and Services of Maryland.

Senate Bill 852, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 16, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose and is grammatically more correct.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 909.
