Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 952.

This kill requires the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to operate a Pharmacy Assistance Program for certain persons whose assets and gross annual income do not exceed certain levels.

Senate Bill 181, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 16, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose.
