Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 965.

This bill repeals certain provisions relating to pensions payable to former employees retired before establishment of the Employees' Retirement System.

Senate Bill 567, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 16, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 965.
