In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1655.

This bill extends a time limit on the authority of Baltimore City to use certain Program Open Space funds for maintenance and operation of any recreational facilities owned and operated by the City under certain conditions.

Senate Bill 1009, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 16, 1978, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 1655.
