In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 1782.

This kill authorizes a State debt of \$4,250,000 for the Maryland School for the Blind for construction of certain cottages, walkways, and ramps.

Senate Bill 1105, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 29, 1978, authorizes a State debt of \$4,225,000 for the same construction purposes.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 1782.
