House Bill No. 2006 - Motion Picture and Television

AN ACT concerning

Motion Picture and Television Development Council

FOR the purpose of creating the Motion Picture Television Development Council within the Department-of Beenemic-and-Gemmunity-Development Division of Labor and Industry; establishing the membership, appointment, and functioning of the Council; giving the Council certain powers and responsibilities; requiring the Council to serve as an advisory body to the Department of-Economic-and-Community-Development Division of Labor and Industry in developing and implementing a program to promote the production of motion pictures television within this State; specifying what this program shall include; requiring the Council coordinate the activities of similar agencies established by local governments; and requiring the Council to recommend to the Department of Economic and Community Development <u>Division of Labor and Industry</u> any legislative or administrative actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act; and providing for the termination of this Act.
