WHEREAS, the City Council desires to impose an uniform tax levy on both the tangible personal property (domestic share) and franchises (operating property) of public utilities and railroads within the corporate limits of the City in accordance with Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

NEW WINDSOR

(Carroll County)

RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of the Town of New Windsor adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 edition, as amended and replaced), title "Corporations - Municipal", subtitle "Home Rule", to amend the municipal Charter of the Town of New Windsor by amending Sections 11-28 and 11-31(a) and by repealing and reenacting with amendments Sections 11-3, 11-32 and 11-35 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1976 edition), to change the elections of the Council members so that approximately one-half is elected every two years for a term of four years rather than all five Councilmen being elected the second Tuesday in May in every second odd-numbered year for terms of four years.
