Resolution No. 1977-5

A RESOLUTION of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Sykesville adopted pursuant to the authority of Section 3 (Home Rule) of Article XI-E (Municipal Corporations) of the Constitution of Maryland and of Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, titled "Corporations - Municipal", subtitle "Home Rule" to amend the Charter of the Town of Sykesville (being Sections 18-1 to 18-98 inclusive of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County (1976 Edition) and being Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, by repealing and re-enacting, with amendments, Section 18-68 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Carroll County (1976 Edition) to provide that Town Council members may be appointed to serve as either a member or chairman on more than one Town Council committee, and otherwise re-enacting Section 18-68 which prohibits conflicts of interest for town employees, the matter hereinafter in CAPITALS indicating matter added to the existing Section 18-68 of the Charter.
