AN ACT to adopt with certain amendments, deletions and additions, the regulations of the State of Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene governing Food Service Facilities, COMAR 10.03.15, effective January 1, 1976, as amended from time to time, by adding new Section 13-8.2 to the Baltimore County Code, 1968, title "Health and Sanitation", Article I. In General.

In General, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments, Sections 25-5, 25-6, 25-7, 25-8, 25-9 and 25-10 of said code and title, Article II. Mobile Riding Units, and by repealing and re-enacting with amendments, Sections 32-6, 32-15, 32-16, 32-17, 32-21(d), and 32-27 of said code, title "Taxicabs", Article II.
