AN EMERGENCY BILL ENTITLED

AN EMERGENCY ACT to extend until June 30, 1978, the period for administration and conclusion of collection procedures pursuant to the Multi-Family Occupancy Tax imposed and in effect through June 30, 1977, by amending Section 75-5 of Subtitle 75, entitled "Taxes" of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County, 1963 Edition, as enacted by CB-77-1976 (Chapter 24 of the Laws of Prince George's County, 1976), and by repealing and reenacting with amendments Section 3 of CB-77-1976.

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT to establish a County Department of Corrections, providing for a Director for same and staff and duties thereof by repealing and reenacting with amendments Subtitle 18, "Police", Division 1, "County Sheriff", Sections 18-101 to 18-110 of the Prince George's County Code, 1975 Edition, and enacting a new Division 1-A, "Department of Corrections", of Subtitle 18 thereof.

AN ACT to amend Section 9-111, titled "Fees for Permits and Inspections," and Section 9-112, titled "Refunds for Unused Permits and Inspections," of the Prince George's County Code, 1975 Edition, as last amended by CB-53-1974, to increase the fees for electrical permits and inspections in Prince George's County.
