18-302. QUALIFICATIONS OF RECIPIENT.

(A) HOLDING OTHER SCHOLARSHIP PROHIBITED.

THE RECIPIENT OF A GENERAL STATE SCHOLARSHIP MAY NOT HOLD ANY OTHER SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS TITLE.

(B) EXAMINATION; WAIVER.

(1) EACH APPLICANT FOR A GENERAL STATE SCHOLARSHIP SHALL:

(I) TAKE A COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD; AND

(II) BE ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION IN THE REGULAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION.

(2) AN APPLICANT WHO IS ATTENDING AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION AND WHO HAS COMPLETED AT LEAST 1 YEAR IN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING AT ~~THE~~ THAT INSTITUTION IS EXEMPT FROM THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT.

(C) RESIDENCE.

EACH APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE; AND

(2) AT THE TIME OF HIS INITIAL APPLICATION, BE A RESIDENT OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT FROM WHICH HE SEEKS APPOINTMENT.

(D) FINANCIAL NEED.

EACH APPLICANT SHALL DEMONSTRATE TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD A DEFINITE FINANCIAL NEED.

(E) OTHER CONDITIONS.

EACH APPLICANT SHALL ACCEPT ANY OTHER CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE AWARD.

Subsection (a) of this section has been broadened slightly. Present Art. 77A, §57(b) prohibits a person who holds a general State scholarship from holding any other scholarship awarded "under the provisions of this article" {Art. 77A}. By
