18-307. ALLOCATION OF FUNDS AMONG LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS.

(A) GENERAL RULE.

EACH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IS ENTITLED TO AN ANNUAL ALLOCATION OF NOT MORE THAN:

(1) \$1,500, OR THE AMOUNT THE DISTRICT RECEIVED IN FISCAL YEAR 1976, WHICHEVER IS MORE; AND

(2) \$2,000 FOR EACH MEMBER ENTITLED TO BE ELECTED TO THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES FROM THAT DISTRICT.

(B) DISBURSEMENT OF MONEY.

EXCEPT FOR STATEWIDE AWARDS UNDER §18-306(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE, MONEY ALLOCATED TO ANY LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT MAY NOT BE USED FOR GENERAL STATE SCHOLARSHIPS IN ANY OTHER LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 77A, §57(c).

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE:

Article 77A, §57(j), which terminated general State scholarship and teacher-education programs existing in 1970, is deleted as obsolete. All awards have expired.

SUBTITLE 4. SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS.

18-401. ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A PROGRAM OF SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS IN THIS STATE THAT ARE AWARDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
