(C) PUBLIC NOTICE OF AWARDS.

THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD SHALL:

- (1) NOTIFY EACH SENATOR OF THE APPLICANTS TO WHOM IT AWARDS THE SENATOR'S SCHOLARSHIPS; AND
- (2) ANNCUNCE PUBLICLY THE NAMES OF ALL RECIPIENTS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 77A, §37.

Present Art. 77A, §37(b) is ambiguous as to whether the Board is to announce publicly the names of the recipients of all senatorial scholarships, or only those recipients it appoints. The revision adopts the former interpretation, which conforms with the current administrative practice.

18-408. APPOINTMENT OUTSIDE DISTRICT.

(A) APPOINTMENT.

IF THERE IS NO QUALIFIED APPLICANT IN A LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT, A QUALIFIED APPLICANT WHO RESIDES IN ANOTHER LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT MAY BE APPOINTED TO RECEIVE THE SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.

(B) TERM OF AWARD.

A SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION IS FOR 1 YEAR. HOWEVER, A STUDENT WHO RECEIVES AN APPOINTMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SUBSEQUENT APPOINTMENT FOR NOT LONGER THAN 3 YEARS.

18-409. LISTING OF SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS.

AT THE REQUEST OF THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD, EACH ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION SHALL PROVIDE THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD WITH A COMPLETE LIST OF ALL RECIPIENTS OF SENATORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS WHO ATTEND THE INSTITUTION.
