(A) "CHILD" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION "CHILD" MEANS A LEGITIMATE CHILD, AN ADOPTED CHILD, OR A STEPCHILD.

(B) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A PROGRAM OF SCHOLARSHIPS THAT ARE AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION.

- (C) QUALIFICATIONS OF RECIPIENT.
- (1) A CHILD MAY APPLY TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD FOR A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SECTION IF HIS PARENT WAS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES, AND:
- (I) WAS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AT THE TIME OF HIS INDUCTION AND DIED OR WAS TOTALLY AND PERMANENTLY DISABLED AS A RESULT OF MILITARY SERVICE AFTER DECEMBER 7, 1941: OR
- (II) WAS DECLARED TO BE A PRISONER OF WAR OR MISSING IN ACTION ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1960 AS A RESULT OF THE VIETNAM CONFLICT AND WAS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AT THE TIME HE WAS SO DECLARED, IF THE CHILD WAS BORN WHILE THE PARENT WAS A PRISONER OF WAR OR MISSING IN ACTION.
- (2) THE CHILD SHALL BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD AND:
 - (I) UNDER 24; OR
- (II) IF THE CHILD SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES, UNDER 28.
 - (D) AMOUNT OF SCHCLARSHIP.

A RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE AWARDED MORE THAN \$500 EACH YEAR.
