

## (A) "CHILD" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION "CHILD" MEANS A LEGITIMATE CHILD, AN ADOPTED CHILD, OR A STEPCHILD.

## (B) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A PROGRAM OF SCHOLARSHIPS THAT ARE AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION.

## (C) QUALIFICATIONS OF RECIPIENT.

{1} A CHILD MAY APPLY TO THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD FOR A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SECTION IF HIS PARENT WAS A MEMBER OF THE ARMED FORCES, AND:

{I} WAS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AT THE TIME OF HIS INDUCTION AND DIED OR WAS TOTALLY AND PERMANENTLY DISABLED AS A RESULT OF MILITARY SERVICE AFTER DECEMBER 7, 1941; OR

{II} WAS DECLARED TO BE A PRISONER OF WAR OR MISSING IN ACTION ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1960 AS A RESULT OF THE VIETNAM CONFLICT AND WAS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AT THE TIME HE WAS SO DECLARED, IF THE CHILD WAS BORN WHILE THE PARENT WAS A PRISONER OF WAR OR MISSING IN ACTION.

{2} THE CHILD SHALL BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD AND:

{I} UNDER 24; OR

{II} IF THE CHILD SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES, UNDER 28.

## (D) AMOUNT OF SCHCLARSHIP.

A RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE AWARDED MORE THAN \$500 EACH YEAR.

## (E) USES OF AWARD; ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS.

AN AWARD GRANTED UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) MAY BE USED FOR:

{I} TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES;

{II} ROOM AND BOARD; AND

{III} BOOKS AND SUPPLIES; AND

(2) MAY BE USED AT ANY INSTITUTION APPROVED BY THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BCARD INCLUDING:

{I} AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION;
