

(I) TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES;

(II) ROOM AND BOARD; AND

(III) BOOKS.

(D) BOND OF STUDENT.

EACH RECIPIENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL GIVE A BOND TO THE COUNTY, WITH SECURITY SATISFACTORY TO IT, THAT AFTER GRADUATION HE WILL PRACTICE HIS PROFESSION IN THE COUNTY FOR AT LEAST:

(1) 5 YEARS IF THE SCHOLARSHIP IS FOR MEDICINE OR DENTISTRY; OR

(2) 3 YEARS IF THE SCHOLARSHIP IS FOR NURSING.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language that combines without substantive change Art. 77A, §§ 62 and 63.

The present references to Baltimore City are deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "county" in §1-101 of this article.

In this section, "county governing body" is substituted for the present "board of county commissioners, county council, or Mayor and City Council of Baltimore".

18-802. SCHOLARSHIPS TO UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE.

(A) "SCHOOL OF MEDICINE" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "SCHOOL OF MEDICINE" MEANS THE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

(B) PROGRAM ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A PROGRAM OF MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, FOR STUDY LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF DOCTOR OF MEDICINE.

(C) QUALIFICATIONS OF RECIPIENT.

EACH RECIPIENT OF A MEDICAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

(1) HAVE BEEN A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS BEFORE THE AWARD;

(2) HAVE BEEN APPROVED FOR ADMISSION TO THE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE;

(3) HAVE FINANCIAL NEEDS AND RESOURCES THAT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD TO ASSURE
