

PROGRAM.

A GRANT MAY NOT BE AWARDED TO A MEDICAL EDUCATION CENTER THAT HAS DISCONTINUED ITS PROGRAM IN PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT OR NURSE PRACTITIONER TRAINING.

(G) ADMINISTRATION OF PROGRAM.

THE STATE SCHOLARSHIP BOARD SHALL ADMINISTER THIS PROGRAM.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 77A, §61B(a) through (d).

The substance of the definition of "accredited program in physician assistant or nurse practitioner training" in present Art. 77A, §61B(b)(5) is inserted in subsection (c) of this section since that is the only place it is used.

The present definition of "program" is deleted as unnecessary.

Present Art. 77A, §61B(e) and (f) which require funds to be included in the budget and provide for the continued independence of participating institutions are deleted as unnecessary in light of the similar general provisions in §§ 18-106 and 18-103 of this title.

The only other changes are in style.

SUBTITLE 9. POSTGRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS.

18-901. POSTGRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS AT UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

(A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A PROGRAM FOR FELLOWSHIPS FOR POSTGRADUATE WORK IN THE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND AT COLLEGE PARK.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS OF RECIPIENT.

EACH RECIPIENT OF A FELLOWSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS SECTION:

(1) SHALL BE A GRADUATE OF A STANDARD 4-YEAR COLLEGE COURSE IN AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION ACCREDITED BY THE MIDDLE STATES ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS OR AN EQUIVALENT REGIONAL ACCREDITING AGENCY;

(2) SHALL BE RECOMMENDED FOR GRADUATE STUDY BY THE EXECUTIVE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTION FROM WHICH HE GRADUATED;

(3) SHALL FURNISH A SURETY BOND TO THIS STATE
