"ANY STATE" MEANS:

- (1) ANY STATE, POSSESSION, OR TERRITORY OF THE UNITED STATES;
 - (2) THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA; AND
 - (3) THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language added to avoid repetitive use in this article of common phrases such as "state, possession, territory, or the District of Columbia". The reference to Puerto Rico is added because it is not a territory or possession of the United States, but is a commonwealth voluntarily associated with the United States. The word "any" is used to distinguish the defined term from references to "this State" or "the State", meaning the State of Maryland.
