

NECESSARY IN PROGRAMS, SERVICES, AND ACTIVITIES; AND

(3) MAKE OTHER STUDIES AND FURNISH REPORTS ON VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN THIS STATE:

(I) ON ITS OWN INITIATIVE; OR

(II) IF REQUESTED BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

(H) GIFTS OR GRANTS.

THE COUNCIL MAY ACCEPT AND ADMINISTER GIFTS, GRANTS, AND APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OR ANY OTHER PERSON ON THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS PROVIDED BY LAW.

21-105. COOPERATION OF AGENCIES MANDATED.

THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, THE STATE BOARD FOR HIGHER EDUCATION, THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES, THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES, THE STATE MANPOWER SERVICES COUNCIL, AND ALL OTHER APPROPRIATE STATE AGENCIES SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN SUPPLYING ANY STUDIES AND REPORTS REQUESTED BY THE COUNCIL. IN RETURN, THE COUNCIL SHALL SUPPLY COPIES OF ITS REPORTS AND STUDIES ON REQUEST.
