21-107. COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCILS.

(A) ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL ON VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN EACH COUNTY.

(B) SIZE OF COUNCIL.

- (1) IN A COUNTY THAT HAS AN AVERAGE DAILY PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE OF LESS THAN 7,000, THE COUNCIL SHALL HAVE AT LEAST 10 MEMBERS.
- (2) IN A COUNTY THAT HAS AN AVERAGE DAILY PUBLIC SCHOOL ATTENDANCE OF AT LEAST 7,000, THE COUNCIL SHALL HAVE AT LEAST 15 MEMBERS.
- (3) IN ADDITION TO THE MEMBERSHIP PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, EDUCATORS AND ADMINISTRATORS IN THE FIELD OF EDUCATION MAY SERVE, EX OFFICIO, AS NONVOTING MEMBERS OF THE COUNCILS.
 - (C) APPOINTMENT OF COUNCIL. .
- (1) THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL APPOINT THE COUNCIL IN ANY COUNTY THAT DOES NOT HAVE AN INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION THAT RECEIVES FEDERAL SUPPORT FOR VOCATIONAL—TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS.
- (2) IN ANY OTHER COUNTY, THE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD AND THE GOVERNING BODIES OF THE INSTITUTIONS AND OF POST SECONDARY EDUCATION THAT RECEIVE FEDERAL SUPPORT FOR A VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM SHALL AGREE ON THE PROCEDURE FOR APPOINTMENT OF THE COUNCIL.
 - (D) QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS.

THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC INCLUDING, ESPECIALLY REPRESENTATIVES OF:

- (1) BUSINESS:
- (2) INDUSTRY:
- (3) ORGANIZED LABOR;
- (4) EACH SEX;
- (5) RACIAL AND ETHNIC MINORITIES; AND
- (6) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE COUNTY.
