EACH COUNTY ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL ADVISE THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND EACH INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION IN THE COUNTY THAT RECEIVES PEDERAL SUPPORT FOR A VOCATIONAL—TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM ON:

- (1) THE DISTRIBUTION OF VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION FUNDS:
- (2) COUNTY VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM ACCOUNTABILITY REPORTS:
 - (3) COUNTY JOB NEEDS: AND
- (4) THE ADEQUACY OF VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL PROGRAMS BEING OFFERED.
