

THE STATE TREASURER SHALL:

(1) BE THE CUSTODIAN OF ANY MONEY RECEIVED UNDER THE FEDERAL ACTS; AND

(2) DISBURSE THIS MONEY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL ACTS.

(C) ADMINISTRATION OF PROGRAM.

THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL:

(1) COOPERATE WITH THE APPROPRIATE FEDERAL AGENCIES IN ADMINISTERING THE FEDERAL ACTS;

(2) DO ANYTHING NECESSARY TO SECURE THE BENEFITS OF THE FEDERAL ACTS; AND

(3) REPRESENT THIS STATE IN ALL MATTERS RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FEDERAL ACTS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language that combines without substantive change Art. 77, §133(2) through (5).

The present list of federal acts is deleted as unnecessary in light of §21-201 of this subtitle.

The present explicit power of the State Board to spend money is deleted as unnecessary in light of its power over administration in subsection (c)(3) of this section.

The reference in present Art. 77, §133(5) to the employment of staff by the State Board is deleted as unnecessary in light of the general provisions of Title 2 of this article.

SUBTITLE 3. VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION.

21-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(B) DISABILITY.

"DISABILITY" MEANS ANY DEFECT OR INFIRMITY THAT MAY INCAPACITATE AN INDIVIDUAL TOTALLY OR PARTIALLY FOR GAINFUL EMPLOYMENT.
