21-305. INJURED WORKERS REHABILITATION.

(A) ADMINISTRATION OF PROGRAM.

THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION COMMISSION SHALL ADMINISTER JOINTLY THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED IN THIS SECTION AND §21-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- (B) INJURED WORKERS REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.
- (1) THERE IS AN INJURED WORKERS REHABILITATION COMMITTEE.
- (2) THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF SIX MEMBERS, FOUR OF WHOM ARE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR. OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS:
 - (I) ONE SHALL BE AN EMPLOYER;
 - (II) ONE SHALL BE AN EMPLOYEE;

(III) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF A CASUALTY INSURANCE COMPANY; AND

- (IV) ONE SHALL BE A REGISTERED PHYSICIAN.
- (3) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE WORKHEN'S COMPENSATION COMMISSION AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION ARE EX OFFICIO MEMBERS.
- (4) EACH APPOINTED MEMBER SERVES FOR A TERM OF 6 YEARS, AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THESE TERMS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS SERVING ON JULY 1, 1978.
- (5) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES CNLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
